School Responsibilities

Registration Procedures:

1. Interview and assessment.
2. Pass the entrance exams
3. Filling online application form.(application for admission).
4. Providing the required documents.
5. Payment of the first instalment fees (accounting staff won't accept payment without written confirmation of the acceptance of the student).
6. Student will be added to school enrolment

Acceptance Conditions:

As Per MOE New age of criteria for acceptance the students:

Fs1- Pre KG	3	01-09-2017	31-08-2018	3 Years
FS2- KG1	4	01-09-2016	31-08-2017	4 Years
Year 1 -KG2	5	01-09-2015	31-08-2016	5 Years
Year 2 - Grade1	6	01-09-2014	31-08-2015	6-8 Years

1. All the applicants to FS1-Pre KG, FS2-KG 1, Year1-KG 2, Year2- Gr.1 and Year 3- Gr.2 will be called to attend an observation/interview through classroom activities, BIPS will be based on the performance in the observation/interview.
2. All other applicants (from Year3-Grade2 and above) must take an entrance examination CAT4.
3. If your child passes the entrance exam you will receive an E-mail to proceed with admission andsubmitting the required documents and payment process.

Parent Responsibilities

Required Documents:

3. 6 recent colored passport size photographs.
4. A copy of student's passport with valid residence visa.
5. A copy of family book (for UAE nationals only)
6. The original Emirates ID + a copy
7. A copy of the birth certificate.
8. A copy of the vaccination card+ medical file from the previous school.
9. A copy of father's passport with valid residence visa + a copy of Emirate
10. **Original continuous studying letter** from the previous school.
11. **Original pass certificate** of the last grade level (from KG onward).
12. **Original transfer certificate.**
13. If a student is transferring from a school located outside the UAE all documents must be endorsed by the ministry of education, the ministry of foreign affairs, and the UAE embassy of the issuing countries.
